CORTLAND BASEBALL IN WORLD SERIES

FREDONIA, NY – The Cortland Red Dragons Baseball team won their NCAA Regional bracket and is one of the 8 teams that will play for the 2007 Division III National Championship. Cortland will face Kean University (NJ) in the first game on Friday at 7:45PM in Appleton, Wisconsin. The Red Dragons enter the 8-team field with the best overall record (40-5).

Cortland won the first game of the Regional bracket over Manhattanville 13-1, but lost the second game to Trinity 2-1 in 13 innings. In the losers bracket, the red Dragons defeated St. John Fisher 17-3 and Trinity 10-6. Undefeated in the regional play, Ithaca was waiting for Cortland in the finals and the Red Dragons took both games 8-5 and 9-4, to win the Regionals and move into the World Series.

The other teams in the World Series include Emory (39-8), UW-Stevens Point (32-15), Carthage College (36-11), Eastern Connecticut State (38-10), Chapman (40-6), and Marietta (32-15).
