SUNYAC HAS 19 INDOOR TRACK & FIELD ALL-AMERICANS

Brockport's Nick Stanisavljevic and Cortland's Fred Joslyn are National Champions

FREDONIA, NY – The NCAA Indoor Track and Field Championships were held this past weekend at the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology in Indiana, and the SUNYAC had 19 athletes earn All-American status, including two National Champions. The Brockport men's team finished in 4th place overall, with 30 team points. Cortland was right behind them, finishing 5th with 23 points. Buffalo State men finished in a tie for 17th with 12 points, and Geneseo was tied for 28th with 5 points. The Oneonta women topped the SUNYAC teams, finishing 13th with 13 points. Geneseo and Cortland followed with 8 points (22nd place), Brockport finished with 7 points (26th place), Plattsburgh had 6 points (28th place), and Fredonia and Buffalo State were in 39th place with 3 points.

Brockport's **Nick Stanisavljevic** was the National Champion in the high jump, clearing 6 feet 11 inches (2.11m), a full inch better than the runner-up. Nick also received All-American honors in the triple jump, where he finished 3rd posting a distance of 48.5 feet (14.79m). Teammate **Josh Dupuis** finished 3rd in the shot put, throwing it 55 feet 3 inches (16.84m). **Jake Basher** was the final Brockport male to earn All-American status, placing 2nd in the weight throw (62 feet 7.75 inches, 19.09m). **Tara Phouthavongsa** was the only Brockport female to earn All-American status, and she did so twice. Tara was the 6th place finisher in the triple jump (36 feet 10.25 inches, 11.23m) and the 5th place finisher in the high jump (5 feet 5.25 inches, 1.66m).

Buffalo State had three All-American's including **Mario Hicks** who was the runner-up in the 55m hurdles (7.49). **Willie Hordge** placed 5th in the 55m dash, with a time of 6.39. **Jenelle Orosz** was the third All-American from Buffalo State, finishing 6th in the high jump. Jenelle posted a distance of 5 feet 5.25 inches (1.66m).

Cortland's **Fred Joslyn** was the National Champion in the 5000m run. Joslyn finished with a time of 14:31.29. Teammates **Andy Cloke** and **Amaan Siddeeq** also earned All-American honors. Cloke was 4th in the mile (4:12.33) and Siddeeq finished 2nd in the 55m dash (6.34). **Christina Acquaviva** finished 2nd in the 55m hurdles, posting a time of 8.10.

Fredonia had one All-American in **Julia Hopson**. Hopson was 6th in the weight throw with a distance of 54 feet 1.75 inches (16.5m).

Geneseo's **Joe Goodspeed** placed 4th in the high jump, clearing 6 feet 8.75 inches (2.05m). **Liz Montgomery** placed 4th in the 5000m run, finishing in 16:56.75. **Meghan Nolan** finished 8th in the mile run, with a time of 4:57.61. Montgomery and Nolan also partnered up with **Diana Snyder** and **Carly Kramer** to earn All-American status in the Distance Medley Relay. The team finished 7th with a time of 11:54.33.

Oneonta's **Kaitlin O'Sullivan** earned All-American status in two events, including the 800m run (2nd place in 2:11.95) and the mile (4th place in 4:52.78).

Toni Wiszowaty was Plattsburgh's All-American, finishing 3rd in the 5000m run. Toni posted a time of 16:55.56.
