Fredonia's Moore, Cortland's Mosher are Coaches of the Year

Fredonia men's basketball coach Kevin Moore and Cortland's women's coach Jeanette Mosher have been named the State University of New York Athletic Conference Coaches of the Year.

Moore won his first Coach of the Year honor after guiding his team to the SUNYAC Tournament finals. Fredonia, the fifth seed, was 18-9 overall, and 10-6 in conference play this year, a complete turnaround from last year's 9-17, 6-10 record. This is Moore's eighth year as head coach at Fredonia.

Mosher was named Coach of the Year for the fifth time while at Cortland (other times: 1999-00, 2003-04, 2005-06, and 2006-07). She guided Cortland to the semifinals of the SUNYAC tournament as the number one seed, with a record of 23-4, 15 -1. The Red Dragons received an At-Large bid to the NCAA Tournament, where they will face St. Lawrence (19-7) in the first round this Friday at the University of Scranton in Scranton, Pennsylvania.
