### SUNYAC Swimming and Diving Championships

FREDONIA, NY – For the eighth consecutive year, Erie Community College’s Burt Flickinger Aquatic Center is home to the State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) Swimming and Diving Championships. Nine men and women’s teams will contend for the conference titles February 9-12 in the 43rd annual men’s and 22nd annual women’s competitions.

The Geneseo women’s team will look to capture their 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive SUNYAC title at this year’s meet. **Erin Walsh (Kenmore/Kenmore West)**, last year’s 500 and 1650 freestyle champion, **Jenny Cocco (Batavia/Notre Dame)** last year’s 100 and 200 breaststroke champion and **Amanda Cavarella (Buffalo/Mt. Mercy)** the 400IM champion, return this year for the Blue Wave to defend their titles. Oswego, who finished four points behind Geneseo in 2004, will also be a big contender for the title. The Lakers took four out of the five relay titles and will return **Leslie Simrell (Ithaca, NY)**, last year’s 200 freestyle champion.

The Geneseo men’s team will also defend their title that they have held for the past seven years. Senior **Dan Allen (Delmar/Albany Academy)** will return for the Blue Wave after placing first in the 50, 100 and 200 freestyle races last year. Last year’s 1650 freestyle champion, **Mike Wiese (Buffalo/Kenmore West)** and 500 freestyle champion, **Dan Kelly (Huntington/Harborfields)** will also return to defend their titles. In addition, Geneseo dominated the relays winning all three free relays. Oswego also placed second on the men’s side at the 2004 championships with 600 point.

The 2005 SUNYAC Championships begin with the diving competition Wednesday, Feb. 9 at noon and continues Thursday, Friday, and Saturday with preliminaries at 10 a.m. and finals at 6 p.m. each day.
