### **2004 SUNYAC Women's Tennis Championships**

*Cortland looks to claim second consecutive title*

FREDONIA, NY – The 21st annual State University of New York Athletic Conference Women's Tennis Championship will be held October 8-10, 2004 at the Eastside Racquet Club in Manlius, NY. Tournament play begins Friday at 6:00 p.m. and continues Saturday and Sunday at 9:00 a.m.

Cortland, 4-0, will attempt to earn its second straight SUNYAC Championship after a dominating performance last year. Head Coach Pete Cahill's team won four of the six singles titles and all of the doubles championships on the way to winning the team title. The Red Dragons return last year's number one singles champion **Laurie Dorscheid (Fairport, NY/Fairport)**, number three singles champion **Andrea TerBush (Liberty, NY/Liberty)**, number six singles champion Meredith McCaslin (**Babylon/Babylon**) and number two doubles champions Dorscheid and **Amanda Husson (Middletown, NY/Middletown)**.

New Paltz will challenge the Dragons this year after being dethroned by them at the 2003 championships. The Hawks return **Kerry Farrell (Rockville Center, NY /South Side)**, **Jennifer Larson (Port Jervis, NY/Port Jervis)** who were all runners-up in their singles flights last year as well as **Sara Goldstein (Merrick, NY/Calhoun)** and **Amanda Rosario (Bronx, NY/St. Jean Baptist)** runners-up in their doubles flights.

Geneseo also has its eye on the 2004 championship. The Knights have had success this year against SUNYAC opponents ending 6-2 and return last year's number five singles champion **Shalini Sudarsanan (Sherrill, NY/VVS)**.

Also participating in the tournament will be Brockport, Fredonia, Oneonta, Oswego, Plattsburgh, and Potsdam.
