2005 SUNYAC Women's Tennis Championships
Cortland looks to claim third consecutive title

FREDONIA, NY – The 22nd annual State University of New York Athletic Conference Women's Tennis Championship will be held October 7-9, 2005 at the Eastside Racquet Club in Manlius, NY. Tournament play begins Friday at 6:00 p.m. and continues Saturday and Sunday at 9:00 a.m.

Cortland will attempt to earn its third straight SUNYAC Championship after a dominating performance last year. Head Coach Pete Cahill's team captured four of the six singles titles and all three of the doubles championships on their way to winning the team title. The Red Dragons roster is stacked with last year's top performers including the number one singles champion senior **Laurie Dorscheid (Fairport)**, who will look to claim her fourth consecutive title. Cortland also returns the number three singles champion **Andrea TerBush (Liberty)**, number four singles champion **Ashley Abar (Champlain/Northeastern Clinton)**, and the number five singles champion **Meredith McCaslin (Babylon)**. The Red Dragons will look to sweep the doubles championships for the third consecutive year as all of last year's Champions return. First doubles champions Dorscheid and **Amanda Husson (Middletown)**, number two doubles champions McCaslin and TerBush, and number three doubles champions Abar and **Jen Hemedinger (Binghamton/ Chenango Forks)**.

New Paltz has finished second at the Championships the past two years and will challenge Cortland again this year for the title. The Hawks return **Jennifer Larson (Port Jervis)** who was runner-up in the fifth singles flight last year as well as **Sara Goldstein (Merrick/Calhoun)**, **Laura Thomas (Hyde Park/Franklin D. Roosevelt)**, and **Eri Yamakawa (Eastchester)** who were runners-up in their doubles flights.

Geneseo also has its eye on the 2005 championship after finishing in third last year. The Knights have posted a 4-2 record against SUNYAC opponents this year and return last year's runner-ups **Krissy Feikert (N. Syracuse/Cicero-N. Syracuse)**, and **Lauren Eichenauer (Rush Henrietta)** in the second and sixth singles flights, respectively.

Oneonta returns **Nicole Lindell (East Greenbush/Columbia)** who will look to defend her number two singles championship. Also participating in the tournament will be Brockport, Fredonia, Oswego, Plattsburgh, and Potsdam.
