Oneonta Earns Top Seed in SUNYAC Women's Soccer Tournament

Red Dragons unbeaten in SUNYAC play

FREDONIA, N.Y. – The State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) Women's Soccer Tournament will begin Tuesday, November 2. New Paltz will travel to Cortland and Brockport will host Geneseo in the opening round. Both games will begin at 1:00 p.m. The semifinals and finals will be held at the Hall of Fame Fields in Oneonta, NY on November 5 and 6 at 1:30 p.m.

The top seeded Oneonta Red Dragons continue to ride a 70-game conference unbeaten streak (69-0-1) dating back to the 1999 season. Oneonta will face the winner of Tuesday's game between Brockport and Geneseo in the semi-finals on Friday, November 5. Brockport tied Cortland's conference record 6-3-1 but was seeded behind Cortland after losing to the Dragons 2-1 earlier in the season. When the Brockport Eagles and the Geneseo Blue Knights met during the season Brockport won 2-1 in overtime.

Second-seeded Plattsburgh State finished conference play at 9-1 and will play the winner of Tuesday's game between Cortland and New Paltz also on November 5 at 1:30 p.m. Cortland, the third seed, tied the Hawks at zero when they met in October.
